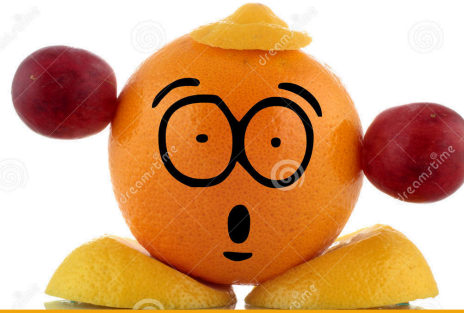


Y4 HOMEWORK

Trip
