



BOOK WEEK



We will start the week off with a special assembly setting the scene for Book Week and we will be asking all children to enter our super competition of 'Designing a Book Cover'. Entries must be returned to school by Friday, 8th March and we will announce the winner during the assembly on the following week.

Thursday, 7th March (which is World Book Day) is going to be extremely busy and to make it extra exciting it is going to be our '**DRESSING UP**' DAY. If possible we would like the children to come to school as a **CRAZY BOOK CHARACTER**. In addition to the many Marvel and Disney characters that will make an appearance, we are looking forward to being surprised at the wide range of inventive costumes that parents have made/resourced. The main aim of Book Week is to enhance the children's love of books and reading.
