On Monday Year 2 had a visit from Lancashire Hawks and Owls who, as a private organisation, are dedicated to rescuing and caring for birds of prey which cannot be returned to the wild. They gave an interactive presentation which highlighted that unfortunately many birds of prey are becoming endangered due to the environment and global issues. Year 2 listened very carefully and asked excellent questions to deepen their understanding and knowledge. All the pupils who wanted their picture taken holding one of the birds had the opportunity to.
