In school this week...

In school this week reception class have been learning about bonfire night, making bonfire pictures with tissue paper. The class have also been working in teams in PE to throw bean bags into a hoop, these were then counted how many where in and out and then added them together.

Year 1 have been developing their computing skills this week by making digital art. Looking at the artist Henri Mondrian the children then created a piece of digital art in his style using the shape, line and fill tools on the Paintz app. The children turned into detectives this afternoon after returning to class to find someone had committed crimes to the fruit and vegetables! The class wrote reports and made predictions on who they thought the culprit could be.

Year. 2 have had another busy week from taking photographs in computing using an iPad, learning basic shapes in gymnastics to building dens in forest school.

Year 3 enjoyed their afternoon in forest school on Tuesday, It is wonderful to see the children learning and enjoying the outdoor area.

Year 4 have been working on their drawing with scissors creating some fantastic pieces of artwork.

Year 5 are learning "Queen We Will Rock You" in their weekly brass lesson and have started exploring forces in science.

Year 6 have been investigating how different 'beaks' enable different birds to eat and trying to work out which type of beak is most effective.

Our y5 and 6 Girls' football team made a great start to the local 3 week tournament last night with 1 defeat, 1 draw and 1 win!





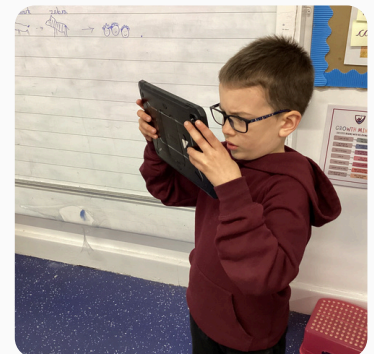
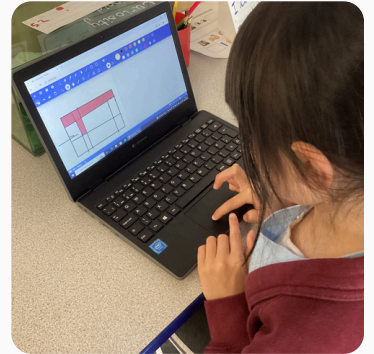
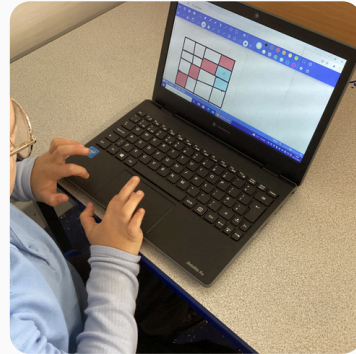
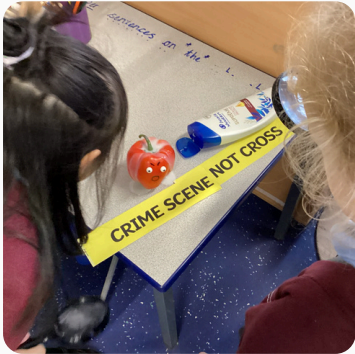
